Park Usage

Hastings Park is a busy place on a beautiful day with families and neighbours enjoying the park.

Please remember:

No Smoking– Hastings Park is a smoke free park

Don't feed wildlife– most foods are harmful to wildlife

Fishing– Anglers are to fish only from the dock at the north end & must clean up after themselves. If something gets caught and can't be reached, please contact administration at 604-253-2311 or on site security at 604-505-4135 for assistance.

Dogs on Leash– Please keep your dog on leash at all times while on site. Off leash areas are available at New Brighton Park and Dusty Greenwell Park. Other park users and children may not know your dog is friendly

Fair time Parking Restrictions

During the Fair at the PNE, car and foot traffic increases, and the PNE will once again be working with the City of Vancouver to have Temporary Resident Parking Only (TRPO) signs installed within the local area. These signs go up the week prior to the Fair.

The PNE encourage all guests to take transit, car pool, bike or walk to the Fair if possible.

The City of Vancouver will be patrolling the PNE area throughout the Fair looking for by-law infractions of back yard parking and non residential street parking for those with Temporary Resident Parking Only (RPO) and Resident Permit Parking (RPP) .
