## CHEAP TRICK CANCELS VANCOUVER SHOW

Vancouver, B.C.: Organizers at the Pacific National Exhibition (PNE) were disappointed to learn that 1980's rock band Cheap Trick have cancelled their Vancouver show, which had been scheduled as part of the free with admission Summer Night Concerts at the annual Fair at the PNE.

"We were very disappointed when we learned the band had cancelled their show at the PNE on their website, it's unfortunate for their fans here in British Columbia," says the PNE's Creative Director Patrick Roberge.

The band, who cited concerns over potential safety issues around the stage, was involved in a unfortunate accident when a stage roof collapsed during a July 17<sup>th</sup> concert in Ottawa.

The stage used at the PNE event, a DYNA Stage 54025, is a highly engineered, a single unit, meaning that the stage and the roof structure are a single structure as opposed to other models of stage that has a separate roof structure attached at the performance site. Further, the stage used at the PNE meets rigorous safety standards and is inspected and approved by an engineer prior to any performances.

Over 100,000 guests attend the free with admission concerts that feature different performers each of the 17 nights of the Fair, which opens August 20<sup>th</sup> and runs through September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2011. The annual Fair, now in its 101<sup>st</sup> year, is the best-attended ticketed event in British Columbia, with an attendance of 952,000 guests in 2010.
