

PAT BENATAR CONCERT AT FAIR AT THE PNE CANCELLED

Vancouver, BC – The Pacific National Exhibition has received word that the final twelve dates of the Pat Benatar tour, including the September 2nd performance at the Fair at the PNE, have been cancelled.

Ms. Benatar announced the cancellations on her Facebook page, citing emergency surgery for her husband as the reason.

"Pat has a large fan base here in British Columbia, and anticipation for this concert was very high," says PNE Creative Director Patrick Roberge. "This is a huge disappointment but I know that I speak for all of her Canadian fans when we wish her and her husband all the best."

An announcement about a replacement artist will be made shortly. Reserved seat ticket holders will be offered a refund at point of purchase, Ticketleader.ca.
