Vancouver, BC – The Fair at the PNE is honoured to show their respect and admiration to the brave community members who put their lives on the line in the name of duty at this year's PNE's Heroes' Weekend, August 16 and 17. Current or retired Canadian paramedics, firefighters, military personnel (Army, Navy, Air Force), members of the RCMP and local police forces, Coast Guard, and Search & Rescue may show their valid ID at the gates to receive free entry to the Fair all weekend long.

"These service members and first responders are true heroes and serve as an inspiration for our community," says PNE President and CEO Mike McDaniel. "They honour us every single time they put on their uniforms, so we want to honour them with this special Heroes' Weekend and show our gratitude for their service and bravery."

Canadian first responders with valid ID will receive free and unlimited access to all exhibits; nightly concerts including performances from Phillip Phillips, Joan Jett and the Blackhearts, Dal Richards, AJ Woodworth and The Matinée; as well as hundreds of additional shows and attractions. In addition to regular Fair scheduling, the PNE and the public will also be celebrating these local heroes with a variety of first responder displays, including antique vehicles, command centre exhibits, and a performance from the VPD Pipe Band.
