

PNE STATEMENT RE: TIESTO SHOW SECURITY

Vancouver, B.C.: The Pacific National Exhibition continually places guests safety and security as a key priority at the over 1,800 events which attract over 3-Million guests to our site annually. As with all events, the PNE works closely with the Vancouver Police Department to ensure guest safety, and the organization welcomes the increased police presence at the Saturday December 31st Tiesto show to be held at the Pacific Coliseum. As per normal procedures, the PNE will have 120 uniformed security guards staffing the event and guests entering the venue will be subject to customary bag and person search procedures.
