'GETTING THERE' FOR THE 2011 FAIR!

Vancouver, B.C. – With the 2011 Fair at the PNE about to open its gates this Saturday, August 20th, the 17-day end-of-summer tradition will have a number of transit options for Fair-goers.

Parking:

If you choose to drive we encourage you to park in one of the PNE's secure, well-lit lots. On site at the Fairgrounds, the PNE has 3300 spots will be available at a flat rate of \$20/day (\$14.75 plus tax). An additional 700 spots will be available on weekends during the Fair at nearby lots within blocks of the Fairgrounds.

Transit:

The PNE urges our guests to use alternate or public transportation to the Fair. In addition to regular transit routes, TransLink offers additional bus service during the Fair at the PNE. Buses include the #16 PNE Special from 29th Avenue Station stopping at Renfrew SkyTrain Station; #210 PNE Special from Phibbs exchange in North Vancouver; and the West Vancouver Blue Bus Special from Horseshoe Bay. Cycling:

Safe, secure and free bike valet parking service is available to fairgoers. The service can be found inside Gate 1 (Hastings & Renfrew). Bike racks are also available outside Gates 5 and 13 (Pacific Coliseum and Playland).
