## WINNERS ANNOUNCED IN RED ROBINSON'S TALENT SHOWDOWN

**Vancouver**, **BC** – Three talented, young Lower Mainlanders have walked away from one of the most prestigious talent competitions in the province with spectacular bragging rights following the popular Red Robinson's Talent Showdown at The Fair at the PNE.

**Cole Armour, 10, of Langley, BC**, won the first place Grand Prize of \$5,000 yesterday after singing "Nessum Dorma" during the competition's finals.

Second place went to lyrical dancer **Maxine Chadburn, 17, of Surrey, BC,** who won \$2,000 and has been selected as the youth representative for BC to perform at CAFÉ, Youth Talent Contest.

And **Jessica Cox, 17, of Coquitlam, BC**, took home \$1,000 and the third place title after singing "Taylor the Latte Boy."
