#### **Rides to watch for:**

Along with Playland classic attractions like the Hell's Gate, the Crazy Beach Party, the Wave Swinger and, of course, the classic Wooden Roller Coaster, the 2006 Fair at the PNE will feature the brand new **Zero Gravity**. Best described as a rapidly spinning disc mounted on a giant arm that elevates to a 45 degree angle, this ride is unusual because riders ride standing up. Zero Gravity will be located along Miller Drive.

Also new for 2006 is the 100 foot tall **Star Dancer**. This attraction can be enjoyed by riders of all ages, taking guests on a gradual rotation that will give a spectacular view of the Fairgrounds as well as Vancouver's beautiful skyline.
