On Saturday, September 29, members of the Vancouver basketball community gathered around the newly unveiled Nash Family Court. Saturday's event was also attended by NBA star Isiah Thomas, Vancouver Mayor Gregor Robertson, PNE President and CEO Shelley Frost, along with Steve Nash's father.

Earlier in the month, Steve Nash was inducted into the NBA World Basketball Hall of Fame. The NBA wanted to gift him something special to commemorate his induction and honour him in his home province. The NBA decided to make an investment into a local basketball court that has significance to Steve by refurbishing it for the use of the local community, and they chose the basketball court in **PNE's Italian Gardens at Hastings Park**. Steve's all-star career was ignited when he played at the PNE during the BC AAA High School Provincial Championships which used to happen each year in the Agrodome. He is from Victoria so they wanted the court to be in BC and this is a great honour for the PNE.

Local schools and community will be welcome to enjoy the courts forever more. This will be a great legacy and will give the PNE basketball court in Italian Gardens an infusion of color and history.
