Spring time at Hastings Park



Spring is officially here and we are hoping to enjoy a bit more sunshine! Hastings Park becomes a busier place when the sun is out. We wanted to send some friendly reminders to all park users.

Wildlife: Hastings Park and the Sanctuary have many types of wildlife to be aware of. The spring brings ducklings and they make the Sanctuary their home until they are ready to fly. PLEASE DO NOT feed these ducklings or pick them up. This is more harmful than you may think.

Dogs on Leash: Hastings Park is a lovely location to get out and walk your dog. Just a friendly reminder that City of Vancouver bylaws state that all dogs must be on leash in park spaces (off leash areas are available at New Brighton Park & Dusty Greenwell). Even if your dog is well trained, other park users and children may not know this; and we want to keep wildlife safe. We appreciate your cooperation with this and of course, picking up after your dog!

Fishing in the Sanctuary: Reminder to those who fish, the dock at the north end is the **only** location to fish. We ask you to please make sure to clean up after yourself including garbage, fishing line, or lures. If line or lures get caught, please inform PNE Administration so they can get cleaned up.

No Smoking: A friendly reminder that Hastings Park is a smoke-free park.

Slow Down: When driving in and around Hastings Park, please slow down with the increase of park-goers on the grounds. Please also be mindful of where you park and follow parking signs and regulations.
