Remaining Pick-Up Dates for Neighbourhood Fair Ticket Program:

Thursday, August 8 – 9am to 7pm *today*

Friday, August 9 - 9am to 7pm

Ticket pick-up location: The blue booth outside the Administration Building, with the sign "Neighbourhood Ticket Program" (east of the Forum Building). Enter through Gate 2 (large green sign) which is located on Renfrew St, one block north of Hastings St.

Please Note: All residents are required to provide proof of address through a piece of mail (Hydro, Fortis, phone bill etc. or renter's tenancy agreement (*no property tax*)) and a piece of picture ID.

Leftover tickets from this program will be donated to charities after the last redemption date, Friday August 9, so make sure you pick up your tickets at the above dates!

Some of the ways that the PNE tries to alleviate impacts to the community during the PNE Fair include:

PNE Bike Patrol – To keep our area safe, PNE security staff rove throughout the neighbourhood on bikes to ensure safety in the community.

PNE Cleanup Crew – Out in the immediate neighbourhood to help keep the community clean.

Temporary Resident Parking Only Signage – Each year, the PNE works with the City Of Vancouver to put up temporary signage in the neighbourhood to make sure neighbours can park in front of their homes during the Fair. If a sign is missing or if you have any questions on backyard parking regulations or bylaw infractions, please contact the City of Vancouver at 3-1-1.

Backyard Parking – The City of Vancouver allows neighbours to sell parking spaces in their backyard. More information can be found on their website: https://vancouver.ca/streets-transportation/parking-near-hastings-park.aspx

Help your neighbours stay safe. Kindly remind them that the City of Vancouver does not allow patrons to: block traffic; put signs on property; call out to drivers while on the street or sidewalk; and wave signs on the street, sidewalk, or on property.

If selling parking spots, consider staying off the streets and selling your spots on <u>Craigslist</u> or <u>Kijiji</u>, and parking apps such as <u>JustPark</u> or <u>Rover Parking</u>.
