Aurora Winter Festival Coming to Hastings Park/PNE

This November, the <u>Aurora Winter Festival</u> is being held at Hastings Park/PNE, and will expand to fifteen acres to take the festival to a whole new level!

The 2019 event beginning November 22 will be four times larger than the previous year and will feature expanded activities and programming in the Mystical Worlds experience, an increased ice skating surface, a longer tube park, and double the number of rides and games.

Guests will be able to visit the Mystical Worlds which feature giant sculptures, animated sets, brilliant light displays, and a number of fun characters. The festival also features a light tunnel showcasing the Aurora Borealis, a story-time theatre with Santa, a giant tube park, ice skating on the frozen pond, six amusement rides, games, an entertainment tent with live music, a variety of food trucks, and a market with 40 holiday-inspired vendors, among other attractions.


