PNE was a venue host partner for Youth Voices of East Van Youth Policy Conference



Youth Voices of East Van hosted a free, all-day Youth Policy Conference on Feb 21, 2020 at the PNE Forum.

The Conference saw over 100 young people from East Vancouver (and beyond) come together to explore themes of community governance, accountability, reconciliation, and inclusion. This event centered the perspectives of local youth, in particular urban Indigenous, low-income, newcomer, and racialized communities. A policy lens was applied to key issues, including: housing, gentrification, employment, and Indigenous inclusion. It was an opportunity to share food and space and celebrate our community with music, entertainment, and cultural performances. This event was brought to the community by ALIVE, Britannia, ESDC, Our Place, and the PNE.
