Status of Teams

- ▶ Teams at reduced salaries through March 2021
- ▶ 50% Management, 93% union laid off in spring 2020
- Drive-thru events and Playland have allowed us to bring staff back through temp recalls and PT shifts
- Extensive safety protocols/policies developed for staff and guests
- WFH, tech tools and engagement survey
- DEI survey
- ▶ 1500 part time, 2000 Fair, 1000 seasonal, +50 FT still not working



Financial Impacts

- 2020 Budget expected to generate \$8.8M
 - Achieved \$9.03M YTD
 - Opening Playland was unanticipated, Film ahead of budget
 - Trade and music event recovery not happening 2020
- On track for \$10M loss in 2020 (Budgeted -\$10.3M)
- Seeing event optimism for late summer/fall 2021
- City approved a \$10M credit line extension
- Nothing provincially or federally still advocating for at least wage subsidy (CEWS) - \$3.6Million to Dec 1
- Thanks to MP Jenny Kwan and Councillor/PNE Chair Lisa Dominato for ongoing advocacy
