
## Amphitheatre and Heart of the Park

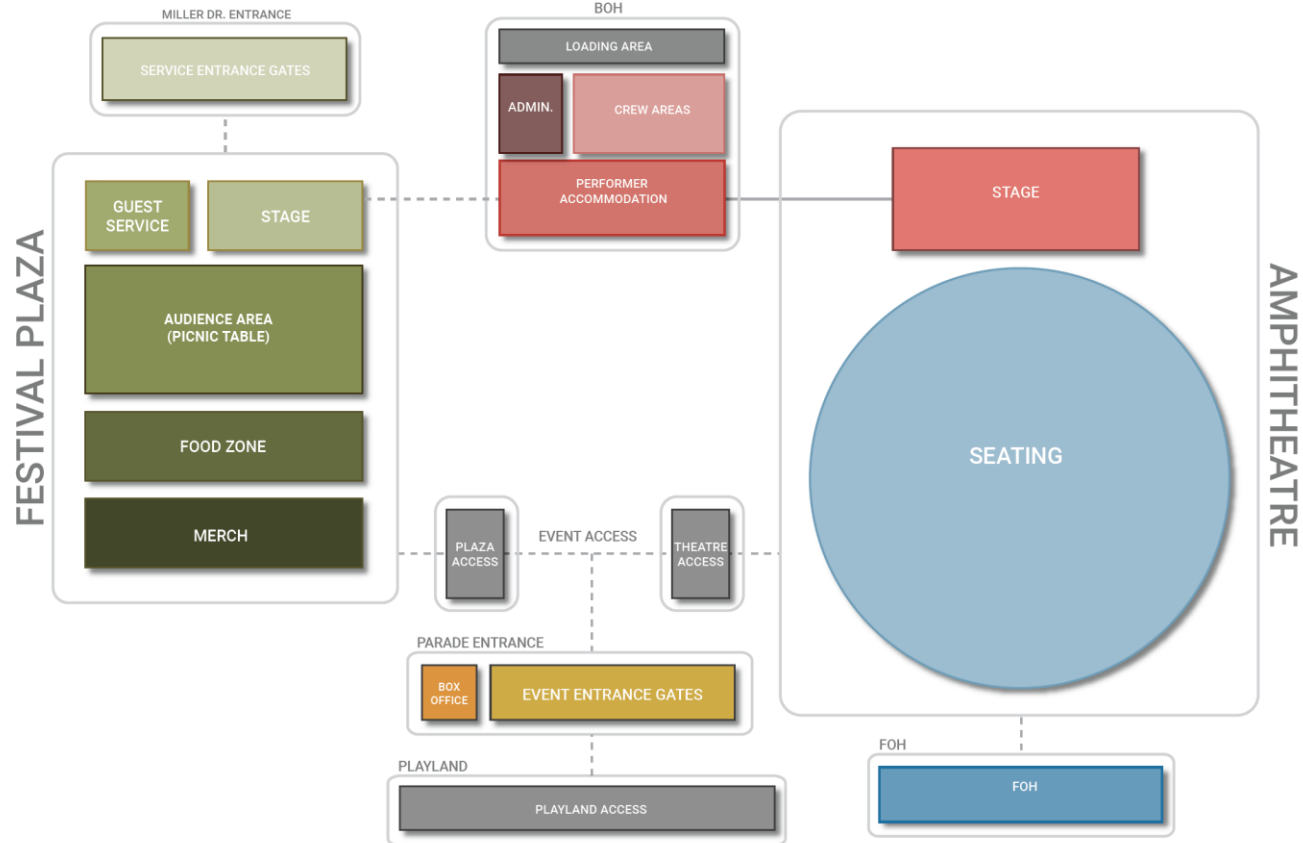
# Amphitheatre Project Goals

- ▶ Aligns to City Strategic initiatives including Culture Shift, Music Strategy, Tourism Master Plan, Economic Action Plan and Healthy City Strategy

- ▶ 3 Public Information Sessions held at PNE in February 2020
- ▶ Communication about Amphitheatre in community newsletters 2020, 2021 and 2022
- ▶ Talk Vancouver Survey in 2020 (~8000 responses)
- ▶ PNE Open House on Amphitheatre Nov 22, 2022
- ▶ Revery Architects will be completing additional community engagement including Indigenous consultation
