# **AGENDA TOPICS**

Prior to the meeting starting, Shelley thanked everyone for their time and commitment to the Community Advisory Committee.

### 1. Japanese Canadian Interpretive Centre

- Karen delivered a presentation on a new community partnership initiative with the Japanese Canadian Hastings Park Committee which would also include the Jon Sasaski's anti monument the Hollow Man
- Both Pasquale and Darci shared that they would also like to see some local, indigenous, and historical art onsite as well
- Karen responded that the interpretive centre and anti monument are part of one project but that the PNE is looking at a different program for art in the park

## 2. Community Website Pages Discussion

 Karen led the group in discussions on both the Community Engagement website and the Community newsletter.





- Some of the comments from the group were:
  - Website
    - A community calendar would be handy
    - The events page calendar doesn't show events on the day of
    - A sit map of the green spaces and what there is to enjoy in each area
    - More interactive website with links to different information
  - Newsletter
    - Maybe highlighting neighbourhood staff
    - How many youth the PNE employs
    - Information on tenants (ie. CircusWest, Rolla Skate Club)

### 3. General Business & Park Update - Karen Massicotte

- Karen gave an update on the following:
  - Progress is being made with the Federal and Provincial funding applications that the PNE has submitted
  - The PNE recently hosting the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual drive thru Lower Mainland Christmas Bureau's gift dro
  - A new fulltime tenant, the Rolla Skate Cub will be operating out the Rollerland Building
  - The PNE is currently evaluating extending community ice program to dry ice leagues from April – June for groups like lacrosse
- Sal asked if any skateboarding groups had reached out to the PNE as he saw a group at Granville Island that was very impressive and well organized
  - Karen replied that at this point no skateboarding groups have reached out to the PNE
- Sal also shared that he is part of the Ball Hockey Association and knows that they are always looking for space as well
  - Karen to reach out to Sal once the dry ice program is more formalized

#### 4. WinterLights Update

- Jeff delivered a presentation on the PNE WinterLights that is returning in December
- Darci shared her concerns that the Sanctuary is still being used even if cars are just driving around the area
- Sal suggested maybe a shuttle to tour people through WinterLights versus everyone using their own vehicle
- Courtney feels that with COVID still around that some people might feel more comfortable in their vehicle
- Pasquale feels that at the end of the day, the site is a multi use space and need to keep this
  perspective and balance in mind
- Karen and Jeff both added that the PNE is very respectful when it uses the Sanctuary
