THE NEW PNE AMPHITHEATRE


The PNE is building a brand new, state-of-the-art outdoor Amphitheatre with a capacity of approximately 10,000. Nestled in the 'Heart of the Park' with stunning panoramic views of the North Shore Mountains, this world-class open-air venue will provide much needed mixed-use venue space for top-tier concerts, arts and culture programming, community events, esports events, and more.



SUSTAINABILITY

The renewable energy strategy for the PNE Amphitheatre and Playland is estimated to REDUCE 521 TONNES CO2e per year. This equates to a 27% REDUCTION in total Greenhouse Gas emissions at Hastings Park.
