PNE and the Binners' Project

- Waste-pickers aided by support staff dedicated to improving their economic opportunities, and reducing the stigma they face as informal recyclable collectors.
- The PNE partnered with the Binners' Project in 2016, instantly increasing their event days from 2 to 26.
- In 2023, binners worked 57 economic hours per day at the PNE Fair.

Recent Facility Projects

- Upgraded the Agrodome's emergency generator from diesel-powered to battery based.
- Old Coliseum Score Clock was repurposed, finding a new home on the Sunshine Coast, supporting amateur hockey in a small community.
- Installed meters that will help us monitor and optimize our energy and water usage.

Lighting Replacement Project

- August 2021 March 2023
- From energy-intensive to high-efficiency
- 6,629 old light fixtures and bulbs removed
- 6,165 new LED light fixtures installed
- Projected energy savings: 1,817,000 kWh / year
- Projected electricity savings of \$360,000 / year

Park Projects

A Naturalization of the Sanctuary:

- Dead standing trees altered to make good nesting and shelter locations for birds, bats, insects and fungi.
- Dead felled trees left in the forest to decompose and contribute to the nutrient cycling process.
- Water Retention improvements in Momiji Pond:
 - Expansion joints were repaired to stop water leakage
