

PNE AND TD TEAM UP THIS HOLIDAY SEASON TO HELP LOCAL YOUTH

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Vancouver, BC – The PNE is thrilled to announce that thanks to the generous support of TD Bank Group the PNE has launched a **Youth Accessibility Program** benefiting disadvantaged youth within Metro Vancouver.

As part of the initiative, the program has provided 10,000 tickets to the PNE Fair and 1,000 tickets to the PNE Winter Fair to over 30 non-profit charities.

"This generous donation will allow thousands of young people who might otherwise not have been able to, to attend shows, events, and attractions such as Playland Amusement Park and the PNE Fair," says PNE CEO Shelley Frost. "But equally as important, this grant will fund a jobs skills training program for youth in our region."
